




Regional development policy in Moldova

## National Strategy for Regional Development 2016-2020

- Even if currently the RM is not a member of EU and has not access to EU structural funds, the NSRD 2016-2020 takes into account the provisions of the EU Cohesion Policy, as well as, of the Association Agreement between EU and Moldova
- Mission of NSRD 2016-2020 is to impulse reforms, so that Moldovan nationals are able to benefit from quality public services and socioeconomic welfare.

- Getting a balanced social-economic and sustainable development on all territory of the Republic of Moldova
- Strengthening financial opportunities, institutional and human resources for social and economic development of regions.
- Reducing levels of social economic imbalance between regions
- Support Local Public Authorities and local activities oriented on economic development.
- Developed territorial competitiveness and economic growth

# Regional development through increasing tourism attractiveness

- Increasing rural tourism attractiveness is one of priority areas of intervention of regional development policy and of funding by the National Fund for Regional Development
- Through the strategic Programming Document 2013-2015 was approved 62 regional development projects including tourism projects
